**Subject: Urgent Intervention for the Protection, Security, and Political Future of the Kuki-Zo Community in Manipur**

Respected Hon'ble Prime Minister,

We, the undersigned Chairman and Secretary of the Kuki-Zo Council (KZC), on behalf of the Kuki-Zo people of Manipur, humbly submit this memorandum to draw your kind attention to the grave humanitarian, security, and political crisis confronting our community in the state of Manipur.

The prevailing situation in Manipur continues to deteriorate alarmingly, threatening not only the lives and properties of innocent civilians but also the fragile peace and stability of the entire region. We earnestly seek your immediate intervention on the following pressing matters:

## **1. Deterioration of Law and Order Situation in Manipur**

The state of Manipur continues to witness a serious deterioration in law and order, marked by repeated incidents of violence, bombings, killings, arson, and targeted attacks against Kuki-Zo villages, particularly in areas such as Ukhrul district.

Most recently, three senior church leaders of the Kuki-Zo community were brutally murdered in an ambush allegedly carried out by the NSCN-IM proxy ZUF-Kamson group. This heinous incident has further escalated tensions between the Naga and Kuki-Zo communities, leading to hostage-like situations and raising serious fears of a large-scale communal conflict if urgent intervention is not undertaken.

In light of the gravity of the situation, we humbly request the Government of India to take immediate and necessary steps to secure the safe rescue of those who are still being held captive. We further urge the Government to initiate an investigation by the National Investigation Agency (NIA) into the brutal killing of the three church leaders at the earliest

possible time, so that justice may be delivered and confidence restored among the affected communities.

## **2. Urgent Need for Helicopter Services for Kuki-Zo Areas**

Due to the ongoing tensions with both the Meitei and Naga communities, the Kuki-Zo people, especially those residing in Kangpokpi district, are facing extreme restrictions on movement. Many civilians are unable to travel safely outside their areas, even during medical emergencies and other urgent situations.

In light of these hardships, we request your esteemed office to kindly arrange dedicated helicopter services for the following sectors:

- a. Churachandpur – Kangpokpi
- b. Kangpokpi – Silchar
- c. Churachandpur – Moreh

Such connectivity would provide much-needed humanitarian relief and ensure access to healthcare, essential travel, and emergency evacuation.

## **3. Ensuring Uninterrupted Supply of Essential Commodities**

The Kuki-Zo population in Kangpokpi district is currently facing severe shortages of essential commodities due to disruptions in transportation and supply routes.

We request the Government of India to ensure the uninterrupted movement of essential goods and supplies to Kuki-Zo areas, particularly through the Silchar route, with adequate security arrangements to guarantee safe passage and prevent humanitarian distress.

## **4. Deployment of Security Forces Along Sensitive Boundaries**

The growing tensions between the Naga and Kuki-Zo communities pose a serious threat to peace and security in the hill areas of Manipur. There is an urgent need for preventive measures to stop further loss of innocent lives and destruction of properties.

We therefore request the Government of India to deploy adequate central security forces along sensitive boundary areas and buffer zones between the two communities in order to prevent escalation of violence and maintain peace.

## **5. Relocation of Examination Centres to Kuki-Zo Areas**

Due to the prevailing security situation, Kuki-Zo students and candidates are unable to safely travel to examination centres located in Meitei or Naga dominated areas.

As a result, many deserving candidates are at risk of losing educational and employment

opportunities during this crisis. We therefore request that examination centres for major examinations such as SSC and other competitive examinations be relocated or established in safer locations within Churachandpur and Kangpokpi districts.

## **6. Political Solution Through Separate Administration**

Hon'ble Prime Minister, the continuing conflict in Manipur has deeply fractured relations among the Meitei, Naga, and Kuki-Zo communities. The wounds inflicted by prolonged violence, killings, displacement, and destruction have created an environment where peaceful coexistence under the present administrative arrangement has become increasingly difficult.

The Kuki-Zo people firmly believe that a lasting and peaceful solution to the Manipur crisis lies in the creation of separate administrative arrangements for the three major communities — the Meitei, the Naga, and the Kuki-Zo.

Today, the Kuki-Zo community faces existential threats from multiple sides. For our survival, security, and protection, separation from the present administrative structure has become an unavoidable necessity.

Accordingly, the Kuki-Zo people have already submitted our demand for a Separate Administration in the form of a Union Territory with Legislature, and discussions in this regard are ongoing between our Suspension of Operations (SoO) groups and the Ministry of Home Affairs.

We therefore humbly and earnestly request your honourable office to grant Union Territory status with Legislature to the Kuki-Zo people in order to ensure lasting peace, stability, justice, and security in the region.
